## CREATING AN ONLINE IDEA CULTURE

#### Introduction Letter by IDEA Vice President Liliana Galván

"The more constraints you have, the more creative you can be", is the paradox of creativity that has challenged us in the context of this new world, which requires us to be more creative, innovative, and consistent with our purpose, which is,

to provide an international forum for communicating about, promoting, and advocating for drama/theatre and education in schools, communities and all fields of endeavor and to support development of drama/theatre practice and theory as part of a full human education (IDEA Constitution).

Many questions arise in this context. How to sustain our organization when Covid closes borders? How to save our planet from ecocide? How to work as leaders while schools and students change their ways of learning, socializing and protecting themselves? How to create a new culture that shortens the virtual distance?

As IDEA elected officers, we are creating a new online culture that strengthens our relationships, helps us to cross boundaries, spark interest, and provoke action. That is why we have ended 2021 with the satisfaction of having carried out multiple activities in productive and great interaction with our members and beyond, and have the energies to start this 2022.

Although our nature as drama teachers is to relate to each other in a direct, organic, and close way, we have been able to adapt to new communication platforms, as well as to use new applications to interact in different ways. Democracy needs tools that allow us to regulate time and space to express, debate and reflect on our own discourse.

Working remotely is a great challenge when you lead a multicultural organization, coming from different regions, with different generations, perspectives, and points of view, over 30-year history of sustained face-to-face and eventual virtual communication. Despite this, we have had the opportunity to systematically hold monthly international meetings with our members (webinars, workshops, celebrations, etc.). In general, our frequency of meetings with our members was every three years during congresses, or through projects or Young IDEA.

One statement that inspires us since Evora 2017 is "Rehearsing the Future, Remaking the Past". For me, this is like our organizational mantra, a common thread for our plans. This 2022, we have started remaking the past, learning from leaders who have left their footprint on IDEA's history. On the other side, we are constantly changing and rehearsing the future,

To rehearse future, we need to work with a systemic approach, articulating our three main committees with autonomy, such as the Executive Committee, Accounting Committee, and the General Meeting Committee. We meet monthly to exchange strategic developments. But we also do cross-systemic work for strategic projects such as the IDEA World Congress, the celebration of IDEA's 30th anniversary, new


concepts and projects and events for members through IDEA Online, etc. The exchange of experiences, perspectives and regional cultures is part of everyday life in IDEA. Each officer has several monthly working meetings. The willingness to work is always driven by the love and dedication we all have as volunteers advocating for art education.

Since the strategic planning that took place in Evora 2017, one of our main goals was to become a *learning organization*, one that transforms itself through listening and learning from experiences within our institution. Furthermore, to be efficient and agile, not to get blocked down in bureaucratic processes, but in democratic and inclusive processes. For this reason, we have held an evaluation of the last General Assembly 2021, which was online, to learn about how we make decisions in critical contexts and how we deal with the consequences. Therefore, to be a learning organization we need to be open, inclusive, with a permanent listening and democratic attitude.

Another major focus was to make IDEA a place of Exchange and Creativity, where members enjoy processes of transformation during meetings and gatherings. This is how from my role of Vice President I have been engaged in new online applications creating interactive online experiences that allow everyone to feel included, active and collaborative. Last year, I offered two Interactive workshops, in which participants discovered their digital identity, their communicational styles, how to expand their voices using post-its, design thinking, and visual resources among others. I will offer in the second part of this year, two more workshops.

To find new ways to link with our Latin American members, to coordinate with our Congress hosting in order to have a permanent communication, to be part of the 30 years IDEA anniversary organizing team, to be part of the executive committee, to design workshops for the community of members, to rebuild with a team our webpage, to organize our IDEA archives in our Google drive and Padlet, or to send a 20 minutes video for a forum to Shenzhen Kids Drama Education Technology, are some of the challenges I have assumed as IDEA Vice President, with great interest, willingness and passion. As you can see, nothing can be done by one

person, everything we achieve is done by working teams. This is part of our new online IDEA culture.

## BENEFITS OF DRAMA IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF LEARNING

Throughout these years of teaching, I've noticed that my students magically changed their attitude, their critical thinking after some classes of Drama. I've been teaching English through Drama techniques for

almost 30 years. I remember that my first Drama trainer told me: "You will see that you are not going to teach just a language, you will see changes in your students' attitudes that you won't be able to believe". In fact, I was rather skeptical to believe but time is wise and it showed me it was absolutely true! However, not everything was plain sailing... quoting George Orwell in *Animal Farm*, "we are all equal but there are some MORE EQUAL than others" I noticed that not everybody had access to Drama classes, these students belonged to an "elite".

Spreading this new method, I traveled to the provinces and to small villages where I was very welcomed by the students who were eager to work in this way but not so by the authorities.

"Lo único que nos salva de lo cotidiano es la hermosa locura que nos ofrece el drama. Gracias, Silvia" This was written by a student who was very happy to act, to play, to laugh, to sing, to dance...

Translation: "The only thing that saves us from the routine is the craziness that Drama offers us. Thanku, Silvia".

There was a woman who was fascinated by this boy, and she asked him, without any jealousy in her voice: "How did you make it?"


#### And the answer was simple:

To mark the 30 years of IDEA, every last Saturday of the month in 2022 an online event is taking place, organized by the IDEA Online Working Group led by Sanja Krsmanović Tasić and by the IDEA 30 Years Anniversary Working Group, led by Tom Willems, IDEA Director of Projects and Concepts. The event consists of the presentation of significant figures that have formed and built IDEA as a worldwide association, through an encounter and dialogue with younger IDEA members from over the world. The event has the purpose of tracing IDEA's 30 years journey through the form of oral history and through building a bridge between generations, the featured members presenting IDEA's past, present and future.

The first session took place on 29th January at noon UTC as an intergenerational and intercultural dialogue between Maria van Bakelen (Netherlands/France), the Honorary President of IDEA and IDEA

President from 1992-1998, and Miao Bin (China), Drama Teacher & Head of Art Education of Tianfu No.7 High School Primary Section, Chengdu, China. The session host and moderator was Sanja Krsmanović Tasić, IDEA President, while the technical host was Borisav Matić, IDEA Administrator.



#### WEBINAR WITH PETER DUFFY

## Using qualitative research platforms for theatre education research - generating and representing data

This workshop, held online via Zoom, had an aim of demonstrating how researchers can utilize technology to organize, visualize and represent data. Peter Duffy shared the process for using a program called MAXQDA to organize coded data into themes, and then transform those themes into scenes for his play based on teacher interviews. There are a variety of digital qualitative platforms that can be used such as NVIVO, Dedoose, Quirkos, Atlas.ti, WebQDA, and many others. The general research and representation principles are similar across platforms, but for the purposes of this workshop, only the MAXQDA platform was used. By the end of the workshop, more than 30 participants from all across the world became familiar with the basic notion of coding, organizing data into

themes, and starting to think about how to shape themes into theatrical scenes.

"I quickly built up the entire framework of the theatre festival which consists of four sections: environmental drama, cultural heritage, avant-garde drama, and future world. Each section includes rich content, such as readers' theatre, dance theatre, improvisational drama, environmental drama reading, English drama, science fiction painting exhibition, rain painting exhibition, etc. The entire structure was then not changed since it was designed, but the content had been continuously revised during the preparation process."

## 8th "MATER TERRA" FESTIVAL Belgrade, Serbia

The eighth edition of the Children's and Young People's Theatre Festival "Mater Terra" took place in Belgrade from the 22nd until the 28th November. As the festival took place online in 2020, because of the Covid-19 pandemic, all the participants were happy to be able to gather face to face and see performances in a live format. Besides presenting the work of drama/theatre teachers and artists working with children and young people, organizing round tables where an exchange of experiences and feedback about the work, the festival consisted also of a number of workshops for drama teachers. Included in the Festival was a five-day training program of the ERASMUS+ project I-TAP-PD (International Teathear Artist Partnership-Professional Development) in which teachers

and artists from Greece, Ireland, Netherlands and Serbia met and participated in creative workshops.
